

At FORGING STEEL PRODUCTS we have implemented an Environmental Management System in accordance with the ISO 14001 Standard and we continue working to reduce our environmental impact, both in the design and manufacture of our products, and throughout the entire life cycle of the same.

However, we are aware that for this we need the collaboration of all our supplier companies, especially those that, given the nature of their activity, may cause greater impacts on the environment.

To this end, we want to remind you of the obligation to comply with the following guidelines:

1. All companies that work for FORGING STEEL PRODUCTS or on its behalf **must comply with the environmental legislation that affects them** in terms of emissions, discharges, waste and other aspects that could be generated as a result of their activity.

Some of the most common are mentioned below for guidance:

WASTE:

- Have authorization as a producer or small producer of hazardous waste.
- Have communication as a producer of non-hazardous waste.
- Segregation and proper labeling of the same in accordance with the regulations.
- Indoor storage and no more than 6 months for hazardous waste.
- Delivery to an authorized manager, keeping the legal documentation of said procedures (Acceptance Documents and Control and Monitoring Documents).
- Waste record book.

SPILLS:

- Have the corresponding discharge permit.
- Comply with the discharge limits defined for the different authorized parameters.

EMISSIONS:

- Have authorization as a potentially polluting company in the atmosphere in case of application of RD100 / 2015.
- Comply with the limits imposed in said authorization.
- Carry out proper maintenance of the air conditioning and refrigeration facilities in order to avoid greenhouse gas leaks.

INDUSTRIAL REGULATIONS:

- Commissioning authorization in the Industry Department for heating, air conditioning, refrigeration, pressure equipment, low voltage, high voltage, storage of chemical products, if available.
- Carry out and pass the regulatory inspections of said facilities.

2. All companies that work for FORGING STEEL PRODUCTS or on its behalf **must monitor compliance with the following environmental practices:**

- The use of electricity, gas, water, raw materials, containers and packaging and waste should be minimized as far as possible through the implementation of good environmental practices.
- Avoid spillage of oils, paints, solvents or other dangerous products or waste, handling them in paved or conditioned areas for the protection of the soil and underground waters.
- Have safety data sheets for all dangerous products.

By signing this document, the company undertakes to comply with the requirements established therein. Likewise, it is responsible for communicating said requirements to its personnel and / or subcontracted personnel and that they have the necessary environmental competence in relation to the aforementioned aspects.
